Nearpod has a library of virtual lessons to engage learners.

There are many pros to using Nearpod when we discuss differentiating.

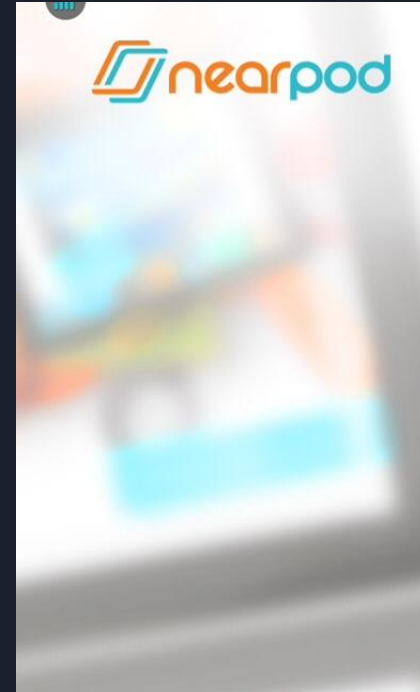
Teachers choose to complete a lesson as Live or Student-Paced.

Many options for short lessons to introduce or review topics.

Nearpod 360 takes students to locations you can't!

Teachers can create their own presentations for their library.

Cons: The free version includes the live lessons only. There is a fee to have the student-paced option.





Adobe Spark



Fast, Friendly, Easy to Share

- *options to build a page format which will load like a slideshow or flyer
- *options to build a video that will play independently like iMovie
- *presentations can include photos, videos, and music.
- *allows for student personalization
- *CON: There is an age limitation for use on the free accounts.



FlipGrid

Upload quick videos for students to respond to a teacher prompt.

Great for fast exit tickets! More engaging than classic exit tickets.

Easy to use for students and good confidence building activities for students needing differentiation.
